June meeting of the POWERS LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES called to order at 5:30 PM by MO. May minutes / June agenda: accepted as submitted.

Jeff Allen present as representative of Friends of Powers Library; Colin Cahill present for ML account review.

Public Comments: No other members of the public present.

Treasurer's Report: AK – statements from Cahill, Knobel & Assoc. sent out by email; ML endowment funds, regular account: 5/30/2025 - \$211,234.69, 4/30/2025 - \$211,874.67; managed fund: 5/30/2025 – 524,886.12, 4/30/2025 - \$510,383.37; 5/2/2025 Groton Bank statement balance: \$87,194.08.

• Investment portfolio update with Drew Osborne: Drew presented handout of account overview/history; 4.17% interest earnings on money market fund; portfolio is cash heavy at this time – almost 30% of holdings; KM made the motion to bring cash portion of fund down to recommended 20% of total account, 80% into equities (stocks), JG seconded, motion approved, Drew will make this change strategically according to best practices; AK made the motion to move funds from Groton bank account into money market account, per Colin recommendation for cash flow management, JG seconded, motion approved.

Old Business

- NY Forward Grant MO request for extension of contract submitted; more info to come.
- Annual Report to the Community-steps for distribution MO this year is the earliest publication of report; perhaps distribute to supporters, with invites for 145th anniversary?
- Bylaws Review: BT Several sections of old bylaws may or may not be necessary in revised version, items in question handed out, after discussion: Article VIII Indemnification of Trustees and Employees Against Liabilities and Expenses in Action should be kept; Article IX Earnings, Assets, Dissolution and Political Activity should be kept with language change regarding "A. 2. The Association shall not operate for a profit." Language should not give the impression that a fund balance is not allowed; BT to continue with revision, for approval at July meeting.
